SUBJECT: REVISION IN THE AGE CRITEREON FOR SCREENING OF PATIENTS AT INTEGRATED SCREENING DESKS (ISDs)

Referring to the subject cited above, Provincial Program for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases Punjab has revised the guidelines regarding age criterion for screening of patients against non-communicable diseases (NCDs) at integrated screening desks established at secondary level healthcare facilities across Punjab. The revised age criterion shall be as follows:

“All the patients aged 35 years of age (Instead of 40 years of age) presenting at any secondary level health care facility shall be referred from central registration point (CRP) to Integrated screening desks for screening purpose”.

2. The revised criterion must be promulgated from 1st July 2018. You are directed to communicate the same to all the relevant in the district.
